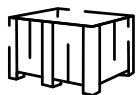

Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for professional packaging is due to take effect in 2026.



PRODUCERS OF professional packaging

Do you produce, import or distribute packaged products or professional packaging?

Under the EPR scheme, you will assume responsibility for managing the end-of-life of your packaging (sorting, collection, processing). If you wish to share some of the burden, you can get support by joining an approved producer responsibility organisation!

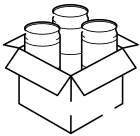
Do you manage the end-of-life of professional packaging by arranging for it to be recycled and/or reused?

You play an essential role: by optimising sorting processes and arrangements for collecting professional packaging, your input is central to ensuring the reuse and successful processing of packaging waste.

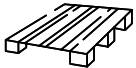
WHICH SPECIFIC PACKAGING TYPES does this concern?



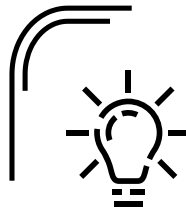
Sales packaging:

Transport packaging:
pallets, inserts, dividers, films,
big bags, etc.



What is EPR?

The Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) requires companies that place packaging on the market to take responsibility for its end-of-life (sorting, collection, and treatment) in order to limit its environmental impact.

Companies can delegate this responsibility to an approved eco-organization by paying an eco-contribution.

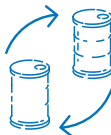

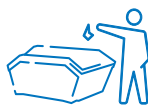
